# CLIL TEACHING SKILLS FOR TEACHERS

#### **Overview**

CLIL Teaching Skills for Teachers course focuses on providing a general overview of this teaching methodology by enhancing and improving the individual's language awareness and teaching skills. Participants look at how to incorporate EFL (English as a Foreign Language) techniques into subject teaching to aid learner understanding of instructions and explanations. The course also aims to raise participants' awareness of the importance of collaboration across English and subject departments and the use of peer observation as a tool for professional development.

Delivered to classes of small groups by way of presentations, guided discovery and class activities. Subject specific lessons may also be delivered to closed groups
